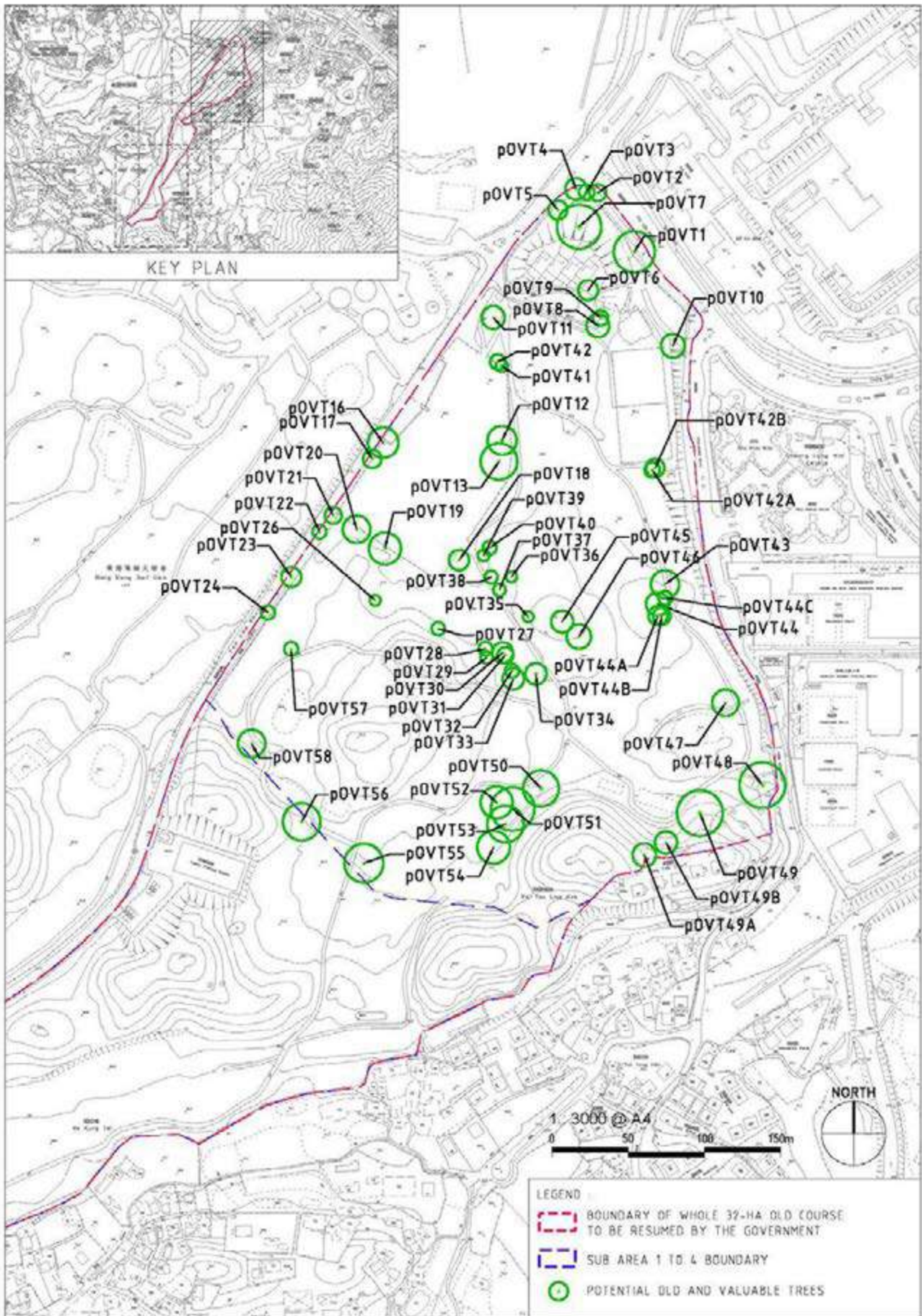

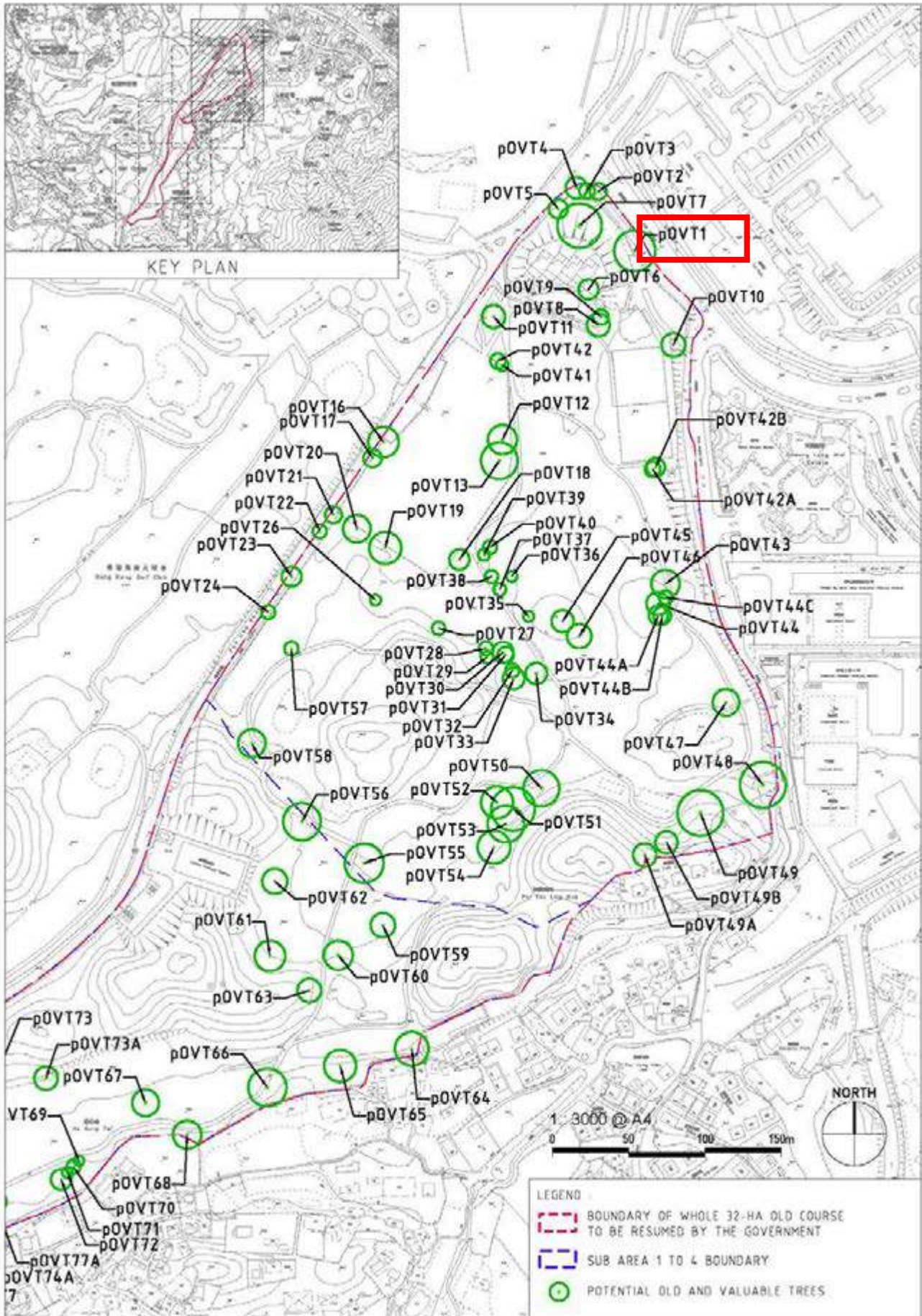

SPECIAL FEATURES: A very large and beautiful mature urban roadside tree of outstanding form and structure. An excellent representative of its species, quite possibly the largest and best tree of this species in Hong Kong. According to an assessment by ecological consultant AEC, Aurecon, some minor broken branches at 5m above ground (Views 5 and 6) provide roosting features for wildlife. The tree has undergone a bark replacement process (called sloughing) during June-August 2023 in which the old, outer, weathered greyish white bark detaches, and the new, unweathered orangish bark emerges. This is an interesting feature of mature <i>Corymbia citriodora</i> (compare Views 1 to 4 which are taken at different dates).				
COMPARISON WITH EXISTING OVTS OF THIS SPECIES ON THE REGISTER: The OVT Register currently has 2 <i>Corymbia citriodora</i> registered as OVTS. The DBH of those trees ranges from 1015mm to 1095mm, with heights from 17m to 24m and crown spreads from 12m to 15m. pOVT1 is considerably larger than the two current <i>Corymbia citriodora</i> OVTS and will be a wonderful addition to the OVT Register.

The DBH of those <i>Melaleuca cajuputi</i> subsp. <i>cumingiana</i> ranges from 700mm to 1565mm, with heights from 9m to 21m and crown spreads from 6m to 13m. The dimensions of pOVT3 are comparable with those existing OVT and it is of particular interest due to the uncommon structure for the species. It will be a good addition to the Register.

While the DBH of pOVT5 falls in middle range of the DBH of existing OVTS, the height and spread of pOVT5 are comparable with the largest existing OVTS. It will be an excellent addition to the Register.

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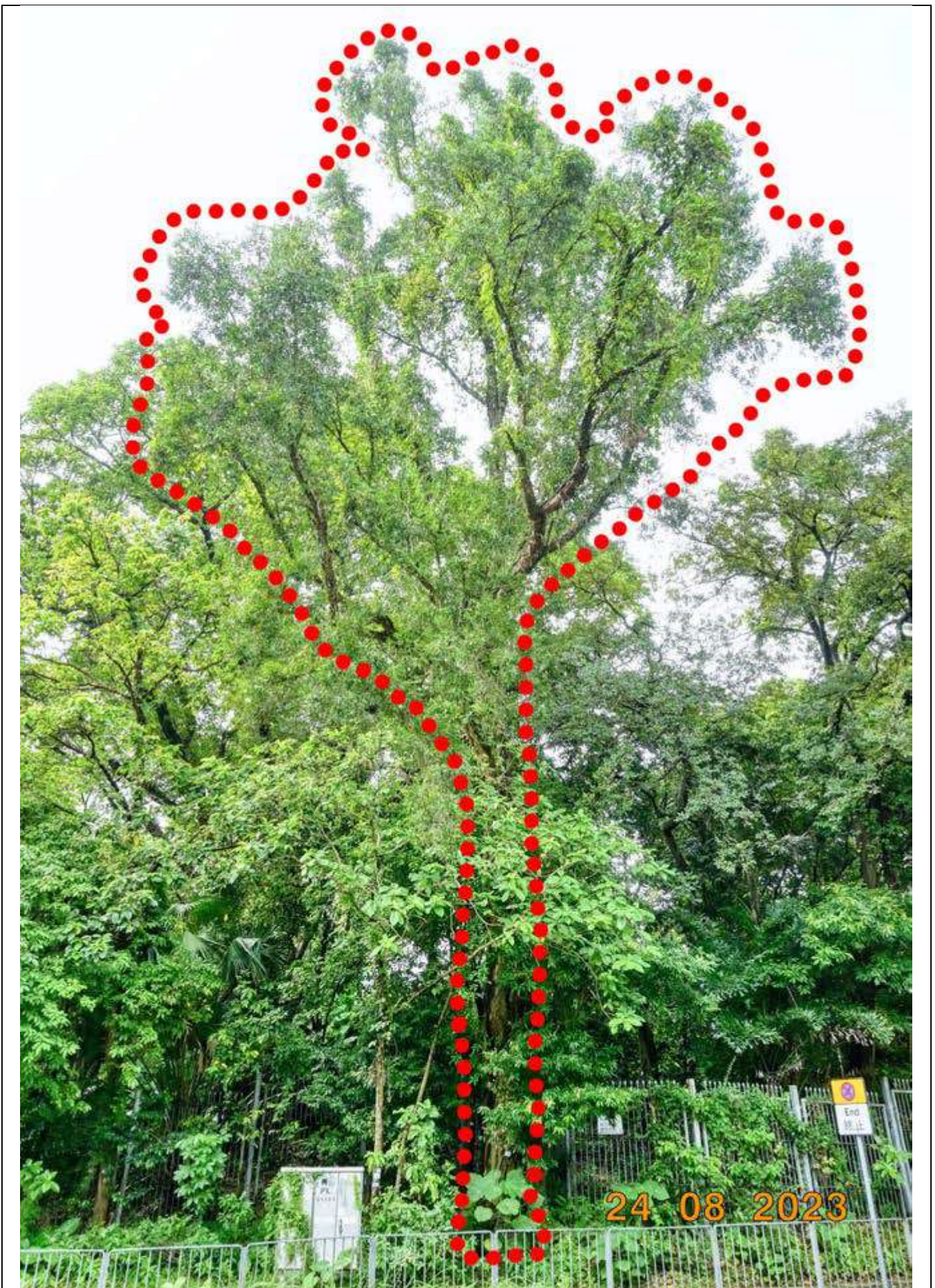

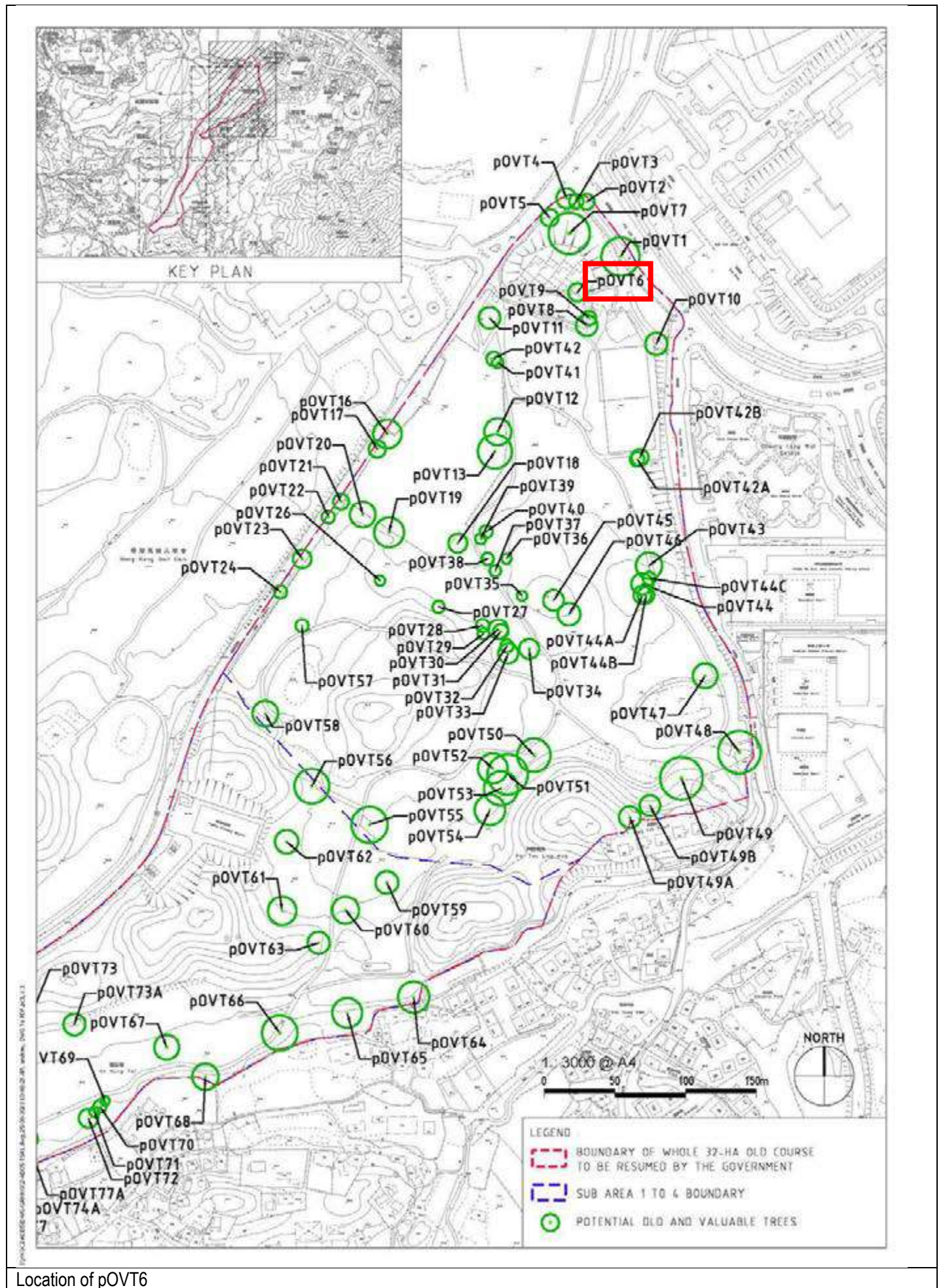

SPECIAL FEATURES: A very large and beautiful mature garden tree of outstanding form. It provides a valuable contribution to local visual amenity with attractive flowering and fruiting. It also provides ecological value by offering food and habitat for insects, and birds. The tree is designated as a Heritage Tree (HT006) in Prof..C Y Jim's " <i>Evaluation and Valuation of Heritage Trees in the HKGC Fanling Site: Old Course</i> " (2020) due to its large size, with a monetary value (in 2020) of HK\$9.7M.				
COMPARISON WITH EXISTING OVTS OF THIS SPECIES ON THE REGISTER: The OVT Register currently has only 1 <i>Dimocarpus longan</i> registered as OVT, with DBH of 1000mm, height of 13m and spread of 10m. While pOVT6 has a smaller DBH than that OVT, it has the same height and larger spread than the existing OVT and is of equally high amenity value. It will be an excellent addition to the Register.

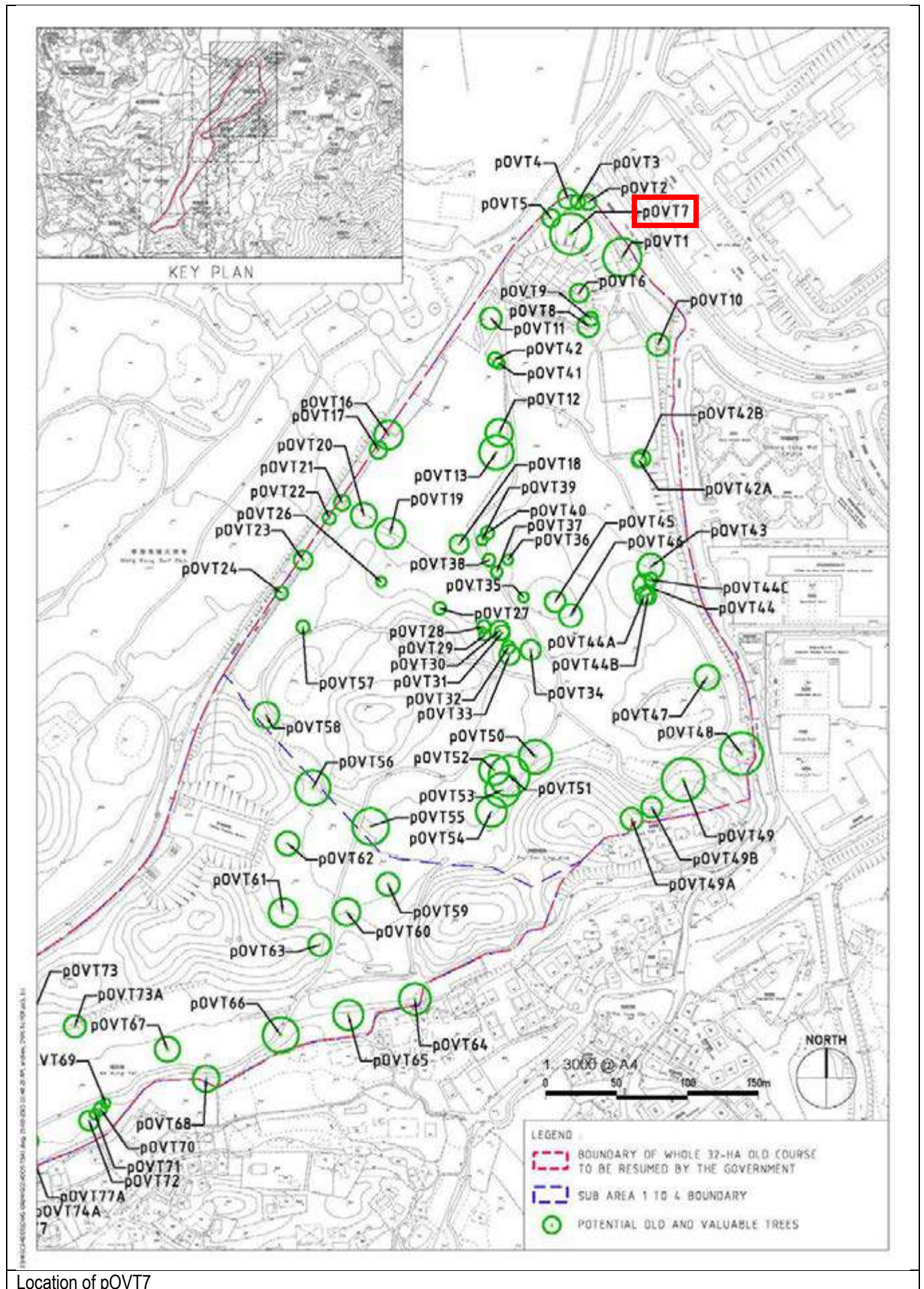

SPECIAL FEATURES: A very large and beautiful mature garden tree of outstanding form, it is one the best and largest specimens of this species in Hong Kong. It provides a valuable contribution to local visual amenity. It also provides ecological value by offering food and habitat for insects, birds and small animals. According to assessment by ecological consultant AEC, Aurecon, three large chambers of complex structures, created from butt-rot with decayed wood found at ground level of trunk provide vast spaces for roosting (View 5, 6 and 7). These, together with the large crown size, make pOVT7 a tree of high roosting potential and help contribute towards its high ecological value. The tree is designated as a Heritage Tree (HT006) in Prof..C Y Jim's " <i>Evaluation and Valuation of Heritage Trees in the HKGC Fanling Site: Old Course</i> " (2020) due to its large size, with a monetary value (in 2020) of HK\$9.7M.				
COMPARISON WITH EXISTING OVTS OF THIS SPECIES ON THE REGISTER: The Tree Register currently has 30 <i>Ficus virens</i> registered as OVTS. The DBH of those trees ranges from 990mm to 2710mm, with heights from 10m to 25m and crown spreads from 10m to 35m. The dimensions of pOVT7 fall within the upper size range of those OVTS, which makes pOVT7 one of the largest and most valuable trees of this species in Hong Kong. It will be a marvelous addition to the Register.

SPECIAL FEATURES: A very large and beautiful mature parkland tree of outstanding size and form. Together with its close neighbour pOVT9, it towers over the surrounding trees and landscape (Views 2 & 3). The two trees combine to create a prominent visual landmark and dramatic visual effect. The smooth creamy coloured bark is also a very attractive feature.				
COMPARISON WITH EXISTING OVTS OF THIS SPECIES ON THE REGISTER: The OVT Register does not contain any specimens of <i>Eucalyptus camaldulensis</i> , although the Register does contain one specimen of the variety <i>Eucalyptus camaldulensis</i> subsp. <i>obtusa</i> with DBH 1296mm, height 19m, and spread 16m. pOVT8 is several metres taller than that existing OVT. The DBH of those <i>Melaleuca cajuputi</i> subsp. <i>cumingiana</i> ranges from 700mm to 1565mm, with heights from 9m to 21m and crown spreads from 6m to 13m. The DBH and crown spread of pOVT17 falls within the range of those OVTs however it is taller than all existing OVTs of the species. Although partially obscured within the woodland, the outstanding form, high amenity value and exceptional height of pOVT57 make it a suitable addition to the Register.

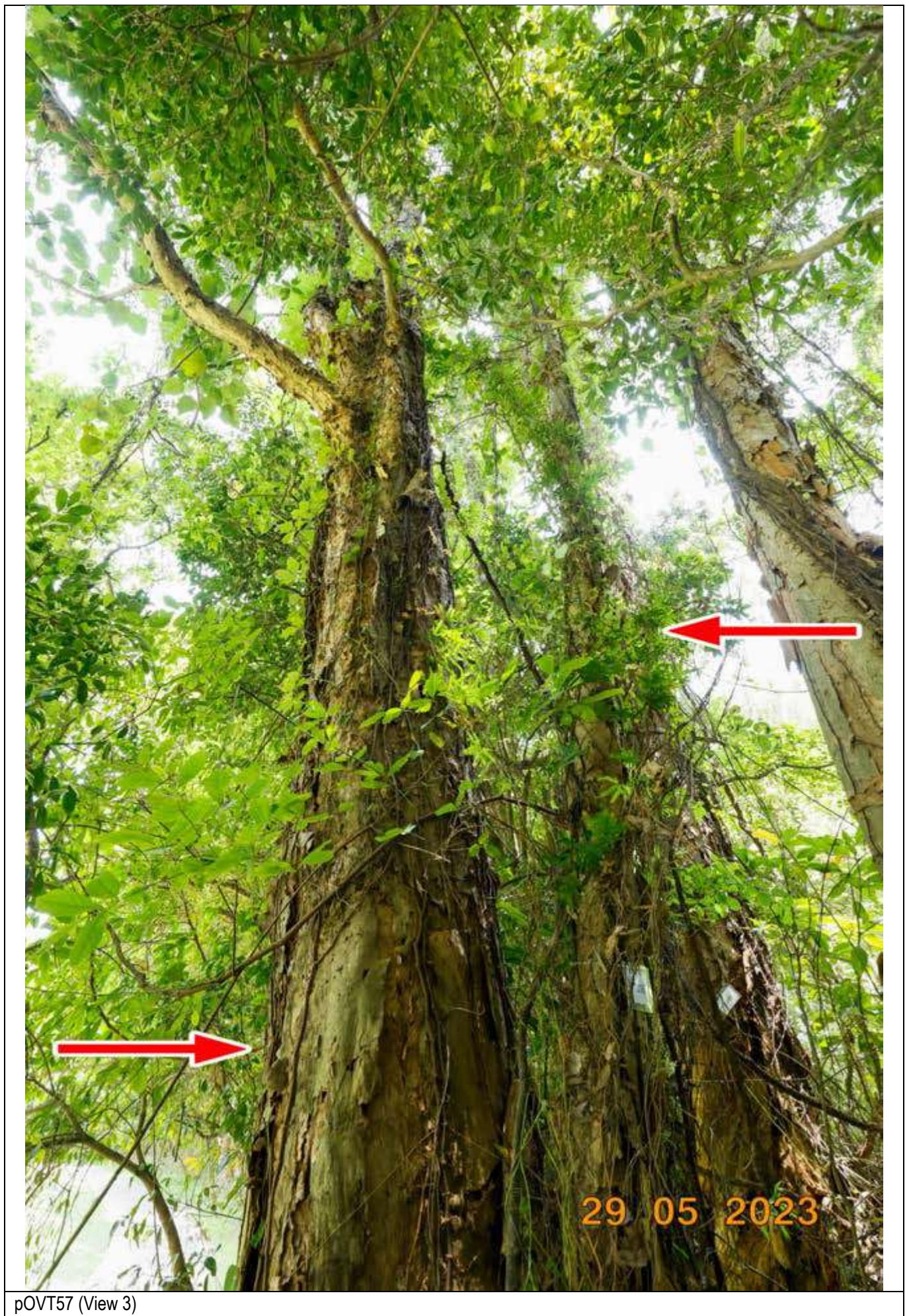
Location of pOVT57

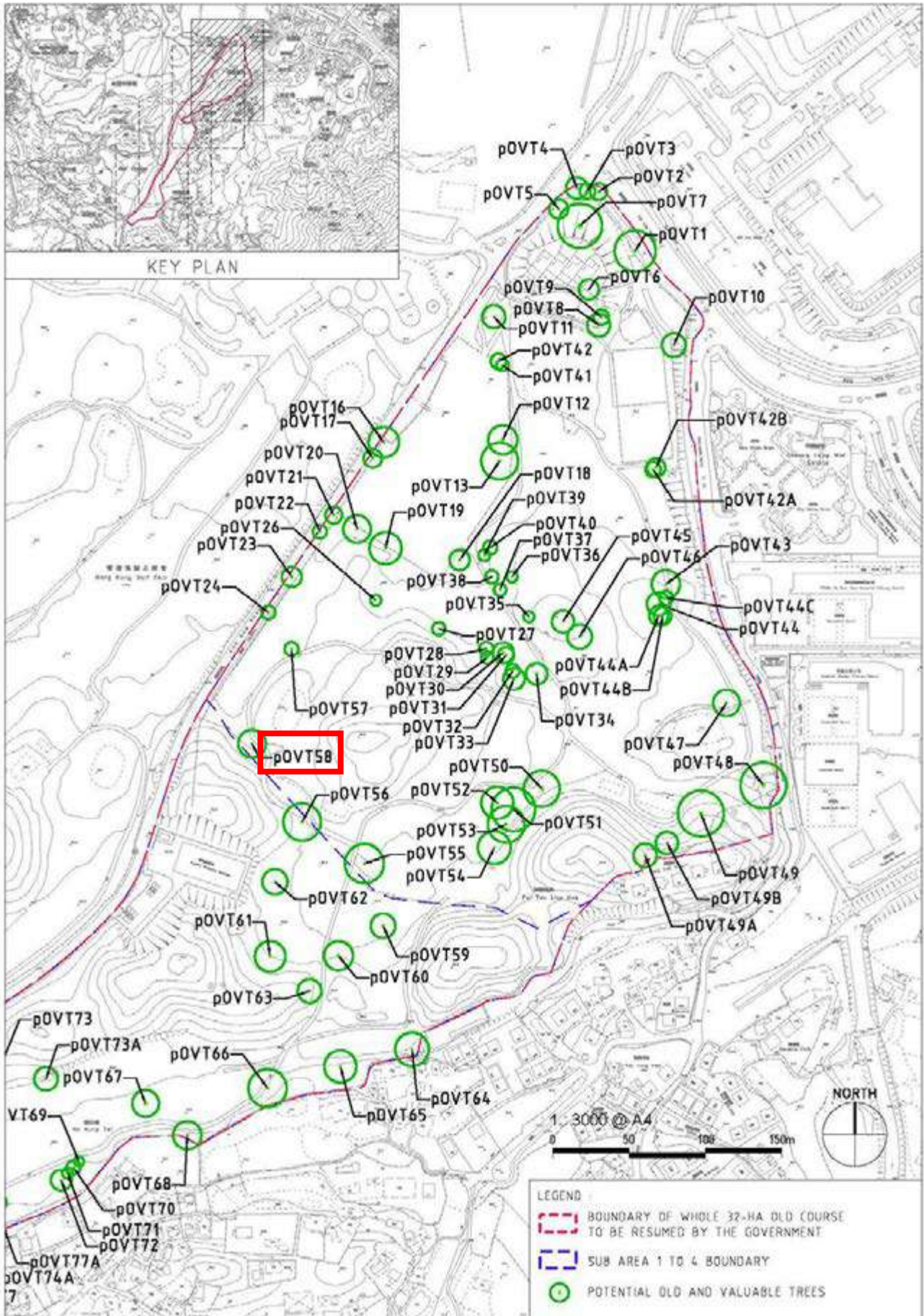

COMPARISON WITH EXISTING OVTS OF THIS SPECIES ON THE REGISTER: The OVT Register currently has 44 <i>Cinnamomum camphora</i> registered as OVTS. The DBH of those trees ranges from 700mm to 3007mm DBH, with heights from 10m to 27m and crown spreads from 13m to 35m. The dimensions of pOVT58 are comparable with those existing OVTS. pOVT58 will be an outstanding addition to the Register as a very old and beautiful specimen of the species as well as being a key component of this important cultural heritage landscape.

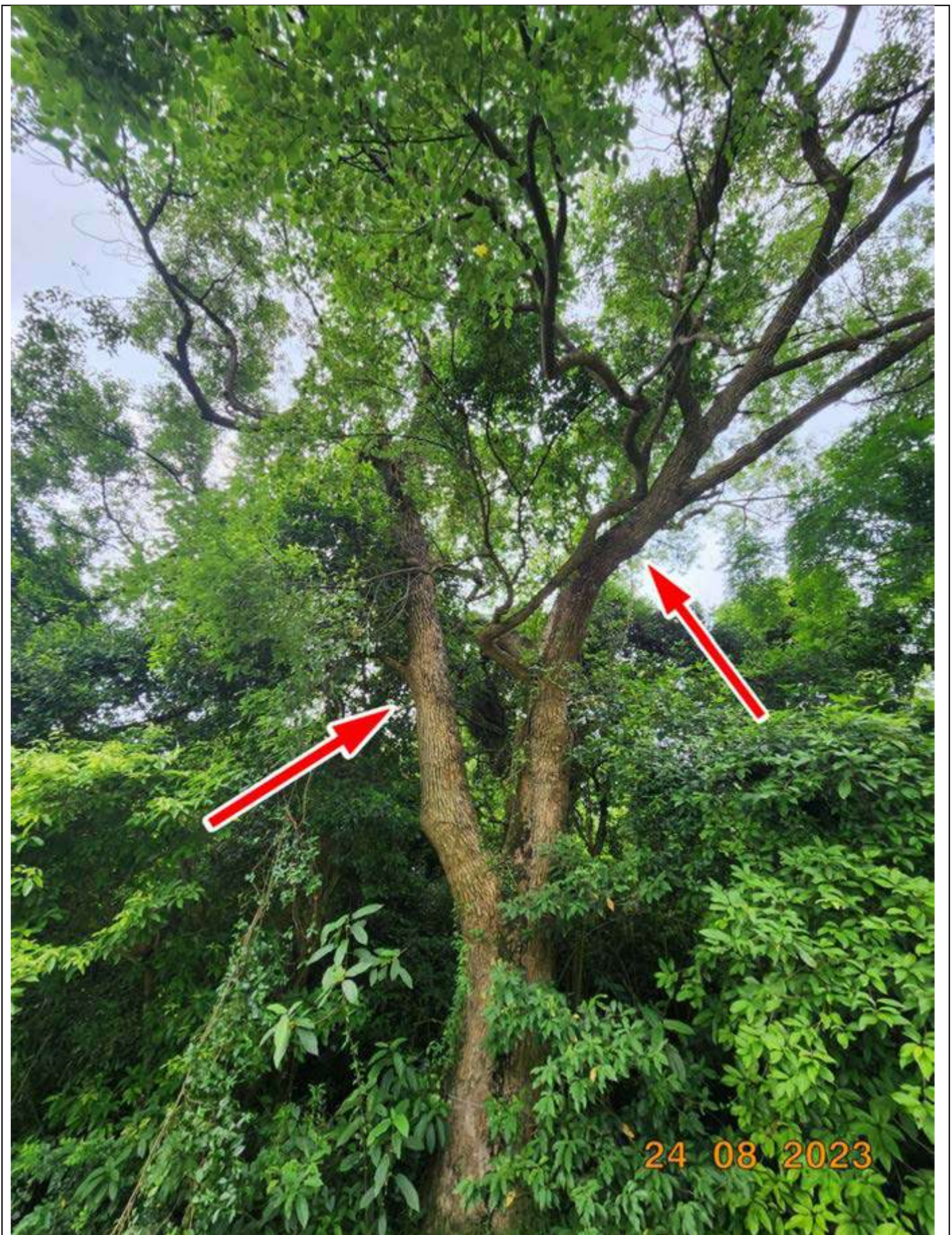
Location of pOVT58



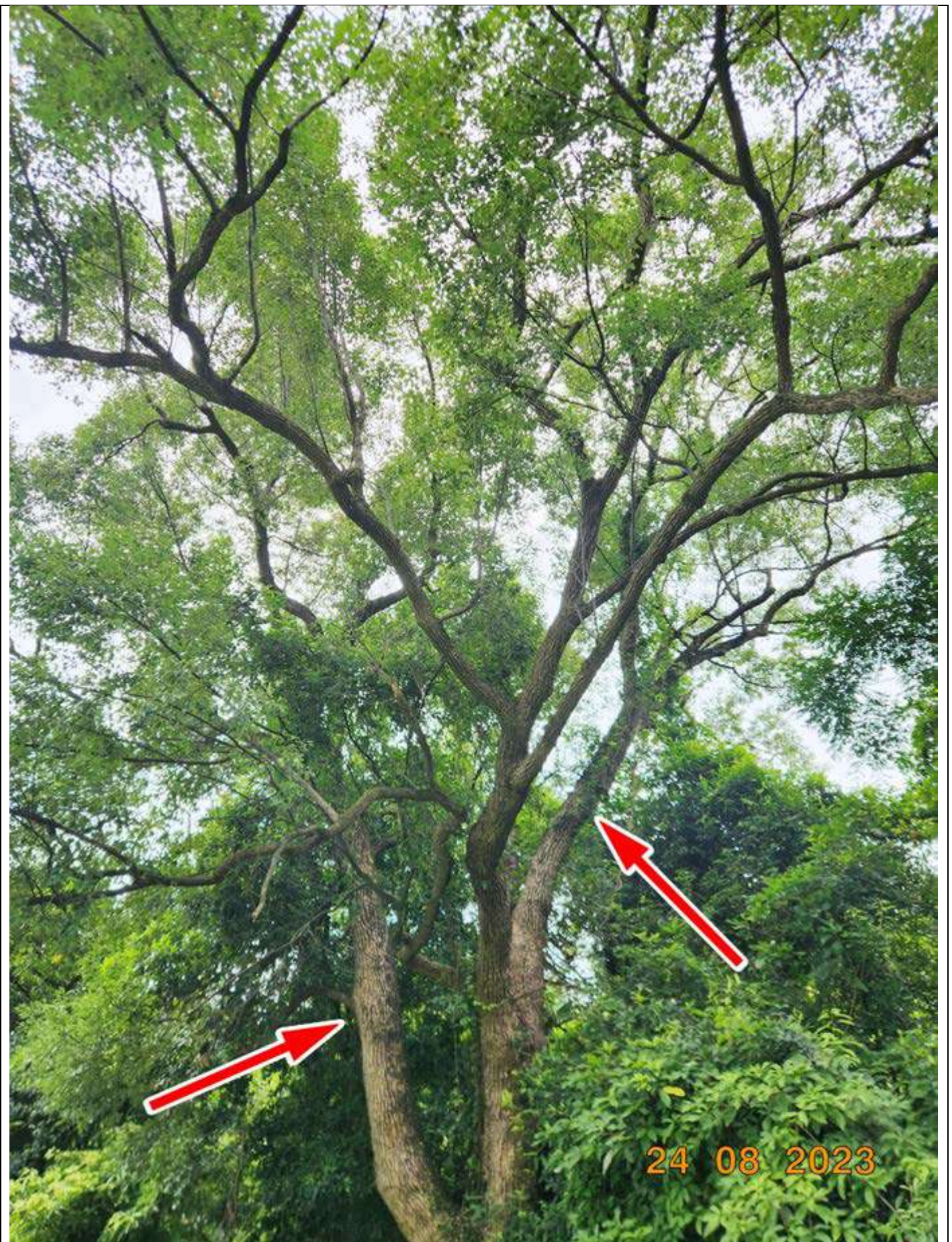

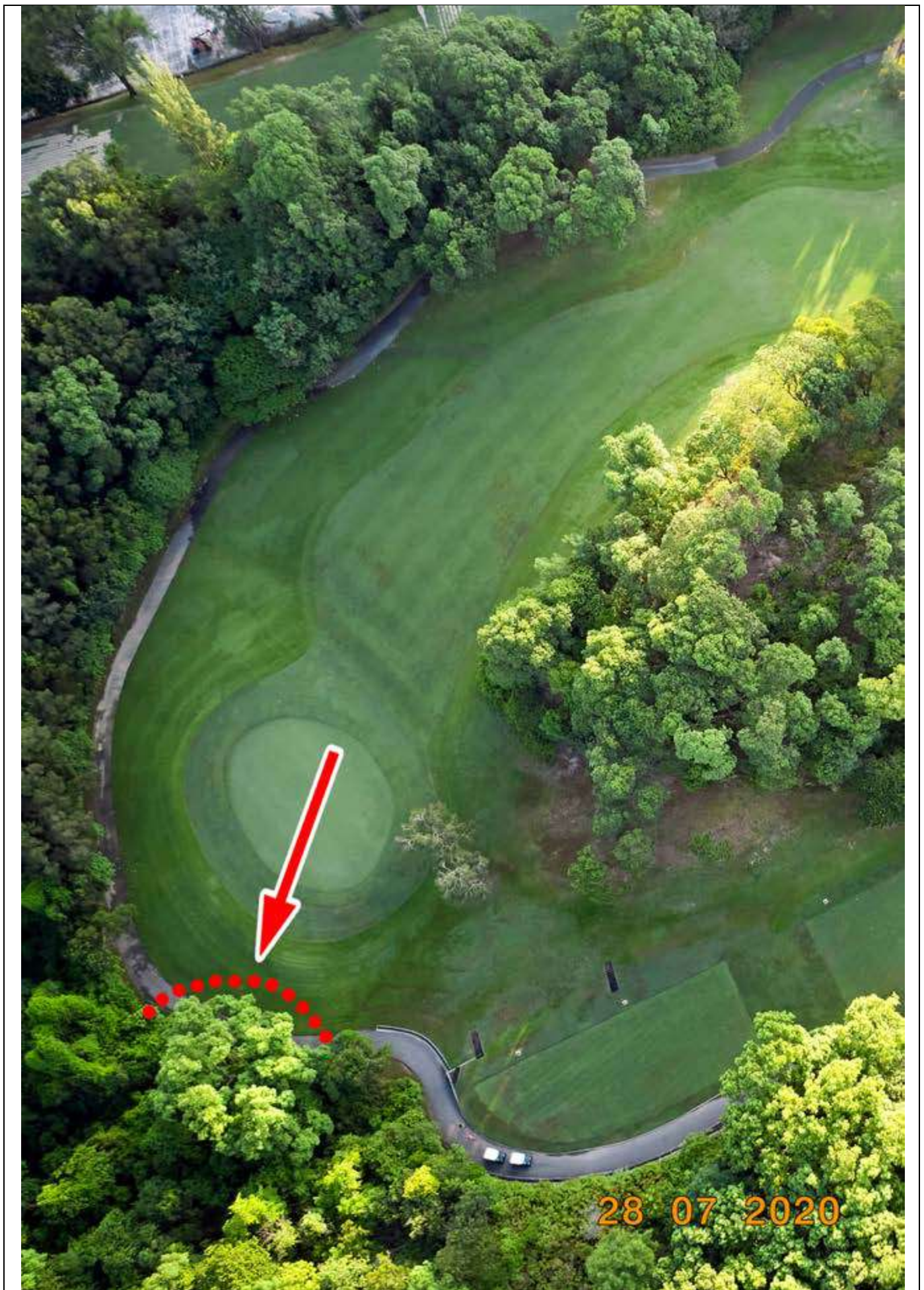
