RULES ON THE USE OF GOLF CARTS



- 1. Carts will be available from 6.00 a.m.
- 2. Carts will be charged at \$400 per cart.
- 3. Each cart may only carry 2 players and 2 sets of clubs.
- 4. Each flight may only take a maximum of 2 carts. However a 2 ball may only take 1 cart between them.
- 5. The driver of the cart must be aged 18 or over and must possess a valid driving licence. Members are required to sign a Declaration Form at Reception before they are permitted to drive a golf cart. Members without a driving licence are required to walk or ride as a passenger in a cart driven by a golfer who is permitted to drive the golf cart.
- 6. Only certified caddies may drive a cart.
- 7. All directional signs must be obeyed.
- 8. Carts may only be driven on the Courses when conditions allow. This decision is entirely at the discretion of the Club. Please ensure you follow the instruction on the cart and at the First Tee. Members, guests and visitors who are found to leave the path when not permitted will be subject to disciplinary action.
- 9. Carts may not be reserved.
- 10. Any damage to the golf cart will be the responsibility of the driver of the cart who shall be liable for the cost of repairs and may also be subject to disciplinary action.
- 11. Cart users must indicate to the Bag Drop if they wish their bags to be transported to the First Tee. Staff will ensure that the bags are installed correctly on the golf cart.
- 12. Carts are not permitted anywhere other than on the Courses proper (i.e. not Driving Range/Car Park).
- 13. Carts are permitted in all competitions.
- 14. A Twilight Cart charge of \$200 from 3.30 p.m. in the Winter season and 4.30 p.m. in the Summer season will apply.
